

The Events Center list of safety and other limitations

- Neither the Natrona County School District nor the City of Casper are responsible for loss, injury, theft or damage of any type or kind, including to property or person. Each person participates at his/her own risk.
- Items left at the Events Center may incur a storage fee for which the responsible person, including students, may become responsible.
- All participants, parents and sponsors agree that they will not use any decorative materials prohibited by City ordinance, including but not limited to: crepe paper, cellophane, confetti, cotton, corn stalks, leaves, evergreen boughs, sheaves of grain, streamers, straw, paper, vines, moss, coniferous foliage, helium balloons, propane tanks, or any similar flammable or combustible materials in or about the premises of the Events Center.
- All exhibits and aisles shall be left clear and free of obstruction during performance time.
- The level of illumination in the seating areas will be kept at a sufficient level to assure surveillance of the audience and to readily detect disturbances.
- Taping of any sort is not permitted on any painted surface in the Events Center.
- The Casper Events Center Manager, or his designee, shall have complete charge of the event, and in consonance with the Casper Fire and Police Departments, will take any necessary precautions to avoid any and all disturbances, even to the complete termination of the program in progress or prior to its commencement, should it become necessary to ensure the safety of the public and property.
- Any individual(s) responsible for causing unsafe conduct in any part of the leased premises shall be subject to ejection from the premises and possible arrest by Casper Police Department.
